The Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown's Respect Life Committee has a mission to help create a culture of life throughout the Diocesan area by supporting existing respect life programs and developing new versions. The group focuses on services that promote pregnancy support and provide education to the faithful. Building on the Church's teaching on life issues, while providing practical support and prayer.

The Abortion Presentation covers five key components. The Church's teaching on abortion, fetal development, abortion methods including chemical abortion, loving alternatives, post-abortion healing and common myths. Other component topics also include Euthanasia and End of Life issues.

The Presentation generally lasts about 50 minutes and includes a power point with pictures and videos. This is ideal for Christian and Parochial High Schools, Campus Ministry, Church's and service groups. The program is also adaptable to speak to Protestant Church's and service groups. And has already been presented to protestant denominations in the area.

Whether Catholic or Protestant, we should all agree for the need to provide pregnancy support. Especially, for women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy and are in need of emotional, material, and spiritual support, or in need of post-abortion healing.

Everyone should consider supporting a pregnancy center that provides an alternative to abortion. Likewise, everyone should support and defend the lives of pre-born children at every opportunity!

As scripture teaches us; verbal faith, that is, faith that consists of words without actions, is insufficient. It cannot save, serve, or survive. But everyone profits when the love of God abides in the believer and is expressed through good works. Although, works do not earn salvation, they are necessary as proof of genuine conversion. Real faith results in a compassionate life. Any professing Christian who refuses to help a brother or sister in need casts doubt on the integrity of their own faith.

Faith unaccompanied by works was never alive. A workless faith is a worthless faith. As Martin Luther said, "It is impossible to separate works from faith as it is to separate burning and shining from fire." A better interpretation argues that although good works will never earn salvation, true faith always produces good works because true faith motivates a person to please God. According to Charles Spurgeon: "The child of God works not for life, but from life; he does not work to be saved, he works because he is saved."
