University of Pittsburgh Exposed

At the beginning of May 2021, the Center for Medical Progress (CMP) released a short video exposing the involvement of the University of Pittsburgh, Planned Parenthood and funding by U.S. taxpayers via the National Institute of Health.

The video titled, "Government Sponsored Fetal Experimentation at the University of Pittsburgh and Planned Parenthood." This video can currently be viewed on the CMP website: http://www.centerformedicalprogress.org

Synopsis: publicly available information demonstrates that the University of Pittsburgh host some of the most barbaric experiments carried out on aborted human infants, including scalping five-month-old aborted fetus is to stitch the scalps onto the backs of lab rats to grow human hair, exporting fetal kidneys across the country, and killing infants delivered alive in order to preform liver harvesting for stem cell research - funded by U. S. Taxpayers via the National Institutes of Health and in particular, Dr. Anthony Fauci's NIAID Office.

Local Planned Parenthood of Western Pennsylvania abortion providers supply the aborted fetuses, while pet sponsors the local Planned Parenthood operations, and what looks like an illegal quid pro quo for fetal body parts, forbidden by 42 United States code 289G-2 and 18 Pennsylvania statutes 3216. Pennsylvania law also makes it a felony to experiment on a living fetus or to fail to provide immediate medical care to an infant born alive.

David Daleiden found the Center for Medical Progress (CMP) in 2013 as an anti-abortion organization, after working for Live Action for five years. He was that organization's Director of Research "during early stages" of the project to make secret recordings of Planned Parenthood clinics. The CMP presents itself as "a group of citizen journalist dedicated to monitoring and reporting on medical ethics and advances." Let us march on, not just one day of the year, but every day, until the right to live for every human being is secure.

On the Road to Overturning Roe v. Wade

There has never been a time in the pro-life movement as crucial as this. The Supreme Court of the United States announced that it will hear a Mississippi's 15-week abortion been known as the "Gestational Age Act." The case, Dobbs V. Jackson Women's Health Organization, gives the Supreme Court the opportunity to reconsider Roe V. Wade. The case will determine whether pre-viability restrictions on abortions are constitutional. Arguments are expected to be heard this fall with a decision expected by the summer of 2022. Without the limitation set by Roe, Pennsylvania and other states would be free to make even bigger strides to protect the sanctity of human life. "We are long overdue for the Supreme Court to revisit Roe v. Wade and Planned Parenthood v. Casey - cases that have led to the deaths of over 60 million innocent children and lead many women and men to lifelong regret," said Live Action founder and president, Lila Rose. "The Supreme Court must acknowledge what science has long revealed: that a unique and individual human life begins at the moment of fertilization."

At 15 weeks, a pre-born child has a beating heart, growing teeth, fingers and toes, and can make complex expressions and respond to touch. An ultrasound may even detect the baby sucking its thumb. Babies, born as young as 21 weeks, are capable of surviving outside the womb with medical intervention.

So, the question that remains is what can we be doing during this most crucial time? First, pray. Pray for an end to abortion and that God will open the hearts of every justice on the Supreme Court as they hear this upcoming case. Second, spread the word and educate those around us. Many people are unaware of the tragedy of abortion or how barbaric it really is. If we want to stop abortion, we have to understand the issue itself and tell as many people as we can. Lastly, we need to be committed to our local pro-life organizations. Lend a hand where needed, volunteer, take part in a prayer vigil outside a local Planned Parenthood. Although we are on the road to ending abortion in America, we still have our work cut out for us and the life of every unborn child depends on the actions we take today and in the upcoming months.

About Steve Deace, This Year's Pro-Life Breakfast Speaker

Steve Deace is on Blaze TV radio and podcast for two hours each weekday, right after Glenn Beck. He's an American conservative political activist and talk show host. His show, The Steve Deace Show, is on the Blaze Media platform. On the show he has also joined by co-host Todd Erzen and executive producer Aaron McIntyre. Numerous guest also appear in segments of the show.

Steve is the author of several books and is a prolific writer. He has also been a contributor to Breitbart, Business Insider, Townhall and Politico. He is recognized by the National Media Coast to Coast as an influential voice in his home state of Iowa's first in the nation caucus and he has been frequently quoted in the national media on political issues, especially presidential politics. Steve has also appeared on all three major cable news networks

Steve was born on July 28, 1973, to Vickie McNeely, an unwed mother only 14 years old. After considering an abortion, she decided to bring the pregnancy to full-term. She went on to raise him and three other children as a single mother in the Grand Rapids, Michigan area. She later married when Steve was three years old. Although, he was not formally adopted, he bears his stepfather's surname. Steve's stepfather was abusive to his family throughout his childhood.

Steve attended Michigan State University in the early 1990s, but later dropped out of school. His first job was as a reporter for the Des Moines Register. He also hosted a sports talk show on KXNO (AM) and later an evening drive show WHO(AM).

Steve now hosts The Steve Deace Show on Blaze TV. The show was formally on CRTV until it merged with The Blaze. He previously co-hosted *We Talk Sports* on Blaze TV with former professional baseball player Kurt Schilling.

In a recent podcast, Steve told the story about how he had studied the Bible from cover to cover for the purpose of winning at Bible trivia games. He later became a full convert to Christianity. Much of Steve's remarks in commentary are fully imbedded with biblical values and principles. He often includes biblical references and stories to fully explain the position that he's trying to convey on any given topic.

As an almost aborted baby, Steve has become a very strong supporter and defender of pro-life at every opportunity. He and his lovely wife Amy have three wonderful children: Anastasia, Zoe and Noah. They reside in West Des Moines, Iowa. Steve and Amy are very active in their church, where Steve has lead a weekly discipleship course. Some of the recent books Steve has written are: *Truth Bombs, A Nefarious Plot, A Nefarious Carol* and his, most recent book, which he co-authored with Todd Erzen, *Faucian Bargain: The Most Powerful and Dangerous Bureaucrat in American History*. An audiobook of the coaching bargain is also available and is read by Aaron McIntyre.

Pennsylvania Legislative Update

I wanted to let you know that the Health Committee of the Pennsylvania House of representatives voted 15 to 10 to advance the Down Syndrome Protection Act, House Bill 1500. Committee also voted to advance House Bill 118, which deals with the respectful treatment of the remains of babies who die before birth, and House Bill 904, which means abortions after and unborn child's heartbeat is detected. The bills will now go to the full house for a floor vote.
