He shared compelling stories of operating on babies in utero, doing everything he could to save their precious lives. Board President Susan Rogacs gave opening remarks regarding the upcoming transition in the Federation's leadership (see article on back). Rabbi Yitzchak Kolakowski, Chaplain for the State Correctional Institution at Waymart, then provided the Invocation. After dinner, the Lifetime Achievement Award was presented to Margie Becker of Lifeline of Southwest PA and the Leadership Award to Cecily Routman of the Jewish Pro-life Foundation.

The evening ended with Benediction given by Reverend Reginald C. Johnson, Sr., Executive Director of People for People, Inc. and Co-Chair of the Hope Pregnancy Center! Thank you to all our chapters for your support of this event! We couldn't have done it without you!

PA Pro-Life Federation "Celebrate Life" Banquet

On October 21, 2022, 1,200 pro-life individuals across the Commonwealth attended the 'Celebrate Life" banquet hosted by the Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation in Hershey. Every year, the Federation secures remarkable speakers, and this year was no different. Dr. Ben Carson, world renowned neurosurgeon, 17th Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and founder of the American Cornerstone Institute presented the keynote address. Like previous years, those in attendance left that night feeling uplifted, encouraged, and equipped to continue the fight for the lives of all preborn children in Pennsylvania.

Dr. Carson shared how his pro-choice views turned pro-life when he was reading about slavery and thought, "What if the abolitionists said, 'I don't believe in slavery, but you guys can do what you want to do.' If that was the case, where would the United States be today?" Thankfully, the abolitionists of those days did not back down but stood firmly in the truth of the evils of their day. And we are called to do the same in this generation. We have a moral responsibility when we know that innocent babies are being slaughtered in their mothers' wombs, which is supposed to be the safest place on earth. We have a responsibility to raise our children to know the truth; a responsibility to share the pro-life message to our family, friends, and neighbors; and a responsibility to be active members in our respective local pro-life organizations. Dr. Carson is a fantastic example to each one of us. Standing up for the truth isn't always the easiest thing to do, but it is always the right thing to do. Children deserve someone to speak up for them and if we are alive and breathing today, God has a purpose for each and every one of us.

We must plant our feet firmly in the truth and together we will change hearts and minds and we will change the culture to one that respects and defends life, from the moment of conception to the moment of natural death.

2022 Annual Pro-Life Prayer Breakfast Speaker

This year's Annual Pro-Life Prayer Breakfast was a great success. It was humbling and heart-warming to see so many people come out on a Saturday morning to celebrate life. While we have much to be grateful for, the repeal of Roe v. Wade for instance, now is not the time to relax, our real battle for life is just beginning.

Two awards were presented at this year's breakfast. The Pro-Lifer of the Year Award was presented to



Chelsea Miller for her tireless efforts in promoting pro-life causes throughout the year, including organizing the first 40-Days for Life campaign in Johnstown. The Lifetime Achievement Award was given to Chris Marz and her mother Marie for witnessing to the truth of the sacredness of human life for many years. Neither Chris nor Marie was able to attend this year's breakfast.

There were more than a couple moist eyes in the room as the McDonald's sang a beautiful pro-life song, "Here I am Lord, send me." A special thanks goes out to Matt and Stacey for sharing their

gift of music.

This year's keynote speaker was Nikki Bruni, the coordinator of 40-Days for Life in Pittsburgh, PA. Nikki shared her slow, gradual faith journey as God worked in her life. She talked about how God saved her from sin through the Evangelical Church. She talked about how her personal relationship with God grew as she read His word, how she began to fall deeper in love with Him through His word. She told about how she was broken by the story of Peter being redeemed by Christ asking, "Do you love me?" God eventually called Nikki to the pro-life movement where she was



introduced to 40-Days for Life in 2010. Nikki was led to the Catholic Church, which she describes as, "the greatest blessing of my life," by the Rosary. Nikki has gone on to organize 25 consecutive 40-Days for Life prayer vigils.

Nikki is also an accomplished artist. She brought one of her paintings with her and displayed it during the breakfast. The painting is an eight-foot replica of, "The Innocence," by artist Adolphe-William Bouguereau. Each of the 2,380 squares making up the mosaic has the face of a baby on it; 2,366 squares represent the



number of babies killed by abortion at the Planned Parenthood on Liberty Avenue in Pittsburgh in 2013. There are 14 gold squares within the mosaic representing the number of babies saved by 40-Days for life that year. She created the painting to recognize the dignity and humanity of each baby lost to abortion.

The closing prayer and remarks were given by Retired Pastor Jon Gulnac, of Salix Methodist Church. Pastor Jon reminded us that the pro-life movement is not about politics, it's not about denominations, we are gathered here amid spiritual warfare, we are journeying and battling together for the life of children. And, as he prayed for all women considering abortion, "Lord, use us as your army to bring hope to these women's lives."
